Lotus House Women's Shelter provides shelter, sanctuary and support to women and children in need. Situated in a quiet enclave in the heart of Overtown, Miami, Lotus House serves over 100 women and children daily who are homeless, whether due to domestic violence, medical or mental health issues, disabilities, loss of employment or other economic reasons. A holistic resource center and residence, Lotus House addresses the gender specific needs of homeless women with an



innovative format based on principles of education and empowerment. Women and children are permitted to live free for up to a year, in a respectful, healing environment, accessing wrap-around support services and a wide range of educational, job readiness and community resources. At Lotus House, the minds, bodies and spirits of women and children in need are nurtured and supported to empower them to improve the quality of their lives on every level,


Become a Lotus Angel

\$1,000 provides 345 healthy nutritious meals.


\$2,500 provides a wide range of job readiness and education programming through the Learning Center to women on the work path. This includes one on one coaching, computer skills classes, job search

workshops, job readiness trainings, daycare and transportation assistance, access to computers, copiers, postage, fax and all necessary office supplies and study guides.



\$10,000 provides up to 36 infants and toddlers at a time, with food/formula, diapers, wipes, soap, clothing, strollers and other supplies needed, as well as daycare assistance for up to a month.

\$25,000 provides three meals a day, shelter, clothing, supplies, supportive services, full health and wellness programming, job readiness training and education programming, transportation assistance, daycare assistance, and basic operational costs for approximately 56 women and children served for a month.



LETTERS FROM LOTUS HOUSE

In the words of those we serve...

After years of struggle, bad relationships and drinking away my problems I found myself homeless for the third time in my life. ..The stresses had taken its toll and I needed to go somewhere that was safe for a pregnant woman... In [the] Miami bus station I was scared and hungry. My number one priority was food- I needed to feed the baby and keep hydrated as well. I did what many homeless do - I found the nearest church. My routine was a daily round of churches – for meals and sleep on the curb at night. Eventually I found ... Lotus House. ... The staff was friendly and full of smiles - thank goodness. ... I couldn't believe it. I felt like a huge weight had been lifted off of my shoulders. Security for a year – this was unheard of! I knew Lotus House actually wanted to make sure that I would be able to bring a healthy baby into this world. As I became more and more pregnant it became harder to ride public transportation and Lotus House provided me with rides to my doctors appointments. When my baby was born it was Lotus House that picked me up from the hospital. When I was hungry it was Lotus House that fed me. When I was sad it was Lotus House that gave me a hug. When I was scared it was Lotus House that made me feel secure. For 6 months I was in a real live heaven on earth for a women in need. When it was time for me to leave it was Lotus House that helped me with my resume - something I had been discouraged from working on for years. Today I am forever grateful to Lotus House. The love I received from the shelter is something I will hold dear for the rest of my life. I thank the universe for the kind heartedness of [staff] and pray her Shelter is an example for other shelters.

I leave Lotus House Shelter empowered; I am stronger, smarter, and wiser, humbled, appreciative, and most of all ready to stand on my own.

The Beginning

I once was lost, but now I can see. I didn't know who I was, I was hurt and full of pain, I had to do some soul searching.

When I got to Lotus House, the staff made me feel welcome and it was nothing to worry about, they had my back.

I once heard of Lotus flower, but now I know what a lotus flower is and that flower is me.

Lotus House help me believe in myself, helped me to think in a different manner and approach life in a different way.
