Such a conflict may arise when any of the following parties has a financial or other interest in the firm selected for the award: an employee, officer or agent of the Foundation; any member of an employee's, officer's or agent's immediate family; an employee's, agent's or officer's partner; or an organization which employs or is about to employ any of the parties in the preceding sections. - 1. Sundari Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors members are prohibited from voting on matters relating to County Agreements which may result in the board member directly or indirectly receiving funds paid by the provider under the County Agreement.
- 2. Sundari Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors members are prohibited from voting on any matters in which they are related to the person or entity seeking a benefit as an officer, director, partner, of counsel, consultant, employee, fiduciary, or beneficiary.
- 3. Sundari Foundation, Inc. Board of Directors members are prohibited from directly or indirectly receiving any funds paid by the County to the Provider under a County agreement.
- 4. Sundari Foundation, Inc. employees are prohibited from directly or indirectly receiving any funds paid by the County to the Provider under a County agreement, with the exception of the employee's salary and fringe benefits or portion of the employee's salary and fringe benefits included in an approved budget agreement with the County.
- 5. Sundari Foundation, Inc. will immediately disclose and justify in writing to the OMB-GC any business transactions between Sundari Foundation, on one side, and Board members or staff, on another side as well as all related-party transactions with officers, directors, or employees of any entity that is doing business with Sundari Foundation, Inc.
