Three Programs That Lead to Progress

The Haven of Grace, for up to 13 years, fills a need in the community to help women who are pregnant and homeless. We provide a place to live, educational programs, and long-term support to families with the goal of breaking the cycle of generational poverty.

Maternity Care and Support

- Shelter, nutritious meals, access to individual and group psychotherapies, prenatal and postnatal medical care and case management based on self-directed goal setting.
 - Full term deliveries
 - Healthy birth weights >6.5 Lbs.
 - Mother and child celebrate first birthday
 - Mother begins her journey to independence

Transitional Housing +/- Two Years

- Furnished apartment on shelter grounds for a mother and up to four children under age 12, continued case management support and access to wrap-around services, financial literacy and incubation for community living readiness.
 - Develops good bill paying habits
 - Works full time
 - Saves 30% of salary
 - Manages daily challenges of parenthood
 - Social and emotional experiential learning for families

The Haven Difference - Reduce Homelessness Recidivism

- Holistic support to the family for up to 10 years after a child was born while living at The Haven of Grace.
 - Case management via home visits support system
 - Continued access to mental health services and family counseling
 - Occasional rent and utility bill help
 - Introduction to career options and planning vs- job readiness
 - Positive Parenting Support
 - Access to wrap around services
 - Family friendly educational activities that encourage attainment of good social skills and a curiosity for learning

The Haven of Grace recognizes that each of our moms is an individual on a distinct journey. Advocates meet them where they are to aid with immediate needs and to foster an environment where they can be motivated to self-determination for the achievement of generational liberation.
